

## UBE Umbraco: Display a video

1. Upload your video to You Tube [as described here](#).
2. In the website's back office, decide where you would like to put the video on a page. A column about half a page wide is recommended.
3. In another tab, play your video on You Tube (you can pause it if you like, it doesn't matter).
4. **Right click** on the video and click "Copy embed code". If you're asked, "Allow access". The code you need is now on your clipboard.
5. In the column on the web page in the back office, open the Rich Text Editor (RTE) (click + > Rich text editor).
6. In the RTE's task bar, click the top left icon "<>" (it says "Source code" when you hover over it). A panel opens headed "Source code".
7. Paste the clipboard into the panel (Right click > paste or Ctrl + V). A line or two of code is pasted into the panel; you'll see the URL of the video in it).
8. The code starts with something like "<p><iframe width='xxx' height='480'", where xxx is an integer. Change "xxx" to "100%". You may have to come back and adjust the height value.
9. Click OK to close the source code panel.
10. Click Save and publish.
11. Open the page and play the video. When it is playing, if there is a black area above and below the video, the height value in the source code needs to be decreased; if there is a black area to the left and the right of the video, the height value in the source code needs to be increased. By how much? Guess work!
12. If you need to change the value of the height, click below the video in the back office to display the RTE's task bar so that you can open the source code with the "<>" icon.
