

# UBE Umbraco: Types of Pages

There are three types of Page.

## 1. Common Page

A Common Page type is used to display a page of content on your website. It can be added a Child Page of the Root Page or as a Child Page of a Parent Page (see below).

## 2. Parent Page

When a section of the website needs more than one Common Page, the Common Pages are Child Pages of this Parent Page type. For example, the Parent Page could be “Activities” and its Child Pages could be “Camera Club”, “WI”, “Football”, “History Society” etc.

## 3. Macro Parent Page

Many procedures, called Macros, are available to simplify managing the content of the website, whilst managing the presentation of the content on a web page for you. The Macro itself is added to the Common Page where you would like to display the content and the content is added to Child Pages of a Macro Parent Page.
